<b>Dial</b>	Enamel dial with Roman numerals, two winding holes, brass surround
<b>Case</b>	Mahogany with brass decoration, in the form of a church
<b>Movement</b>	French movement, serial number 2677, striking on a gong
<b>Condition</b>	Good condition commensurate with age. Working order. One or two small bits of wear to veneer to the bottom

Arts & Crafts style clock dated 1886, with brass embellishments, long pendulum representing two weights

The engraved brass plaque mounted to the church roof reads " Presented to Superintendent John Peerless on his retirement from the East Sussex Constabulary by the Magistrates the Uckfield and Mark Cross Benches in whose division he has passed the last of his 39 years faithful service May 1886"
